Cast/Crew Member COVID Safety Measures

Prior to the start of rehearsals:

- Actors/Crew requested to socially distance for two weeks prior to the beginning of rehearsals
- Actors/Crew requested to follow CDC guidelines during the two weeks prior to the beginning of rehearsals: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/prevention.html>

During rehearsal process:

- Temperature check at the beginning of each rehearsal
- Actors/Crew with a temp of more than 100.4F will be asked to leave and quarantined
- Enhanced cleaning practices of rehearsal area (per CDC guidelines)
- Props disinfected before each rehearsal
- Facemasks must be worn during the rehearsal process and throughout the theater
- Directors and choreographers are encouraged to reduce the amount of touching and increase as much distance as possible
- Continued social distancing requested of all actors

During performance:

- Temperature check at stage door, with scheduled arrival times for actors as needed
- Costumes cleaned regularly and separated on the rack for each actor with a plastic barrier
- Actors/Crew wipe down dressing room/work area after each use using provided supplies
- Enhanced cleaning practices (per CDC guidelines)
- Disinfecting wipes and hand sanitizer are located throughout dressing rooms, green room, and backstage/side stage areas
- Backstage areas will be strictly restricted to essential personnel only.
- All props are disinfected before each performance
- Continued social distancing requested of all actors and crew

Facemask use by Actors/Crew:

- Facemasks or face shields will be worn on stage
- Wearing face masks while in the dressing rooms and green room is required
- Each actor will receive "performance face masks" for use while in the dressing rooms and green room that will be laundered/cleaned with their costumes
